**THANK YOU for registering your child with the Huronia Museum March Break Day Camp! We are looking forward to a week full of fun and memories to last a lifetime! We ask you to please read the following carefully to ensure that everyone has a safe and fun-filled time with us!**

### **What to bring to camp**

Please ensure that your child brings the following items to camp everyday:

- Facemask (there may still be places that require it)
- Plenty to Drink (a reusable water bottle is best)
- Lunch and Two Snacks

### **What not to bring to camp**

The following items should not be brought to camp

- Money—Children are not permitted in the store during camp hours
- Electronic Devices
- Cell Phones

**Due to the large number of allergies, and to ensure the safety of all campers, all Huronia Museum camps are peanut free! So please do no pack peanut products, as they will not be able to eat them at camp.**

### **What to wear to camp**

Because we are often using materials such as paint or food colouring, we ask that your children dress in play friendly clothing. We also recommend children dress in layers as we are in and out all day long.

- **Full set of outdoor clothing**
- Extra socks and mittens
- Indoor shoes or slippers

We also recommend putting your child's name in any clothing they bring, as they may get mixed up throughout the day.

### **Skating at the Rec Centre**

Every day we will also be taking advantage of the public skating offered at the Rec. center. In order to take part your child should bring:

- Skates
- Helmet, optional. Our rule is, if you bring a helmet you wear your helmet.

If your child does not wish to take part in skating they will be required to accompany the group but may bring a toy, cards, crayons and papers, or something from home to occupy their time.
